#### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR MARRIAGE IN THAILAND

#### **Foreigners:**

- 1. Affirmation of Freedom to Marry (from the Embassy)
- 2. Passport
- 3. Divorce Certificate

#### Thai

- 1. Thai ID card
- 2. Household Registration Certificate
- 3. Divorce or Death Certificate of Spouse

#### PROCEDURE

(Based on our marriage service)

- 1. We bring you to your embassy in Bangkok to procure the affirmation of Freedom to Marry. Each embassy has a set of requirements and service fee in issuing this document. Please have a look at the succeeding pages for the list of embassies and their requirements.
- 2. We will translate your affirmation into Thai.
- 3. We will bring your translated affirmation to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for legalization.
- 4. We will accompany you to the local district office to register your marriage.
- 5. We translate your marriage certificate into English. And hand the marriage certificate and its translations to you personally if you are still in Thailand. Otherwise we send them to you via courier.

#### Sweden

Obtaining the Affidavit may take weeks, since the citizen needs to sign a letter first and send it to the Swedish Taxation Office (in Sweden) to obtain a certificate stating the citizen's civil status (this may take a week). This certificate has to be certified at their Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The citizen also needs to get 2 reference letters which will support his / her single status. # EXPRESS MARRIAGE REGISTRATION (3-4 DAYS) \$815\* £395\*

Our express marriage registration service (4 working days) includes preparation of Affirmation of Freedom to Marry, translation of the Affirmation of Freedom to Marry into Thai, legalization of the translation at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, preparation of documents using to register your marriage at the District Office, accompanying you to register your marriage at district office in Bangkok, translation of Marriage at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and giving or mailing the legalized translation to you.
